

केन्द्रीय तसर अनुसंधान एवं प्रशिक्षण संस्थान, राँची

तसर उद्योग के विकास हेतु प्रतिबद्ध एक अग्रणी संस्थान

के.त.अ. व प्र.सं. – एक परिचय

केन्द्रीय तसर अनुसंधान एवं प्रशिक्षण संस्थान, राँची वस्त्र मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार अधीनस्थ केन्द्रीय रेशम बोर्ड की एक प्रमुख संस्थान है। तसर उद्योग को अनुसंधान एवं विकास के क्षेत्र में सुदृढ़ आधार प्रदान करने के उद्देश्य से इसकी स्थापना 1964 में केन्द्रीय तसर अनुसंधान केन्द्र (के.त.अ.के.) के नाम से की गई। इसके पश्चात तसर उद्योग के सर्वांगीण विकास हेतु मानव संसाधन प्रशिक्षण घटक को समाहित करते हुए इसका नामकरण - केन्द्रीय तसर अनुसंधान एवं प्रशिक्षण संस्थान किया गया। संस्थान कुल 86.31 एकड़ क्षेत्र में फैला हुआ है जिसमें अनुसंधान व प्रशासनिक भवन एवं पौध-रोपण प्रक्षेत्र के साथ-साथ आवासीय क्वार्टर भी हैं। इसके अलावा संस्थान के नियंत्रणाधीन विभिन्न प्रदेशों में 6 क्षेत्रीय केन्द्र (क्षेरेउअके), 1 पी4 तसर प्रजनन केन्द्र एवं 3 अनुसंधान विस्तार केन्द्र (अविके), चाईबासा में 01 कच्चा माल बैंक के अपने नेटवर्क के साथ संस्थान अपने कार्य क्षेत्र में आने वालें राज्यों को उष्णकटिबंधीय (ट्रॉपिकल) एवं समशीतोष्ण (टैम्परेट) तसर संवर्धन के क्षेत्र के अत्याधुनिक प्रौद्योगिकी सम्बन्धी जानकारी प्रदान करता है।

संस्थान तसर उद्योग के सर्वांगीण विकास हेतु विभिन्न गतिविधियों को संचालित करता है जिसमें विशेषकर अनुसंधान एवं विकास कार्यक्रमों का निर्माण, प्रक्षेत्र के लिए प्रौद्योगिकी का विकास एवं उनका हस्तांतरण, मानव संसाधन विकास एवं प्रशिक्षण तथा सामाजिक विकास कार्यक्रमों का निर्माण शामिल है। संस्थान द्वारा अनुसंधान एवं विकास कार्यक्रमों के अंतर्गत आण्विक स्तर पर अनुसंधान सिंहत विभिन्न प्रकार की गतिविधियां संचालित की जाती हैं तािक तसर रेशम कीटपालन की तकनीकी समस्याओं को सुलझाकर रेशम की उत्पादकता एवं गुणवत्ता में वृद्धि की जा सके। संस्थान के अनुसंधान एवं विकास अनुभाग आधुनिक उपस्करो व संयंत्रों से सुसज्जित हैं तथा संस्थान में स्थापित पुस्तकालय में अंतर्राष्ट्रीय ख्याति की वैज्ञानिक पित्रकाओं, पुस्तकों एवं तकनीकी प्रतिवेदनों का प्रचुर व विशाल संग्रह है। यद्यपि संस्थान को विभिन्न गतिविधियों के संचालन के लिए निधि भारत सरकार के वस्त्र मंत्रालय द्वारा उपलब्ध करायी जाती है, तथापि विशिष्ट अनुसंधान व विकास एवं मानव संसाधन आधारित परियोजनाओं के लिए भारत सरकार की अन्य एजेंसियों जैसे जैव-प्रौद्योगिकी विभाग इत्यादि द्वारा भी राशि मुहैया करायी जाती है।

प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम

मानव संसाधन किसी भी उद्योग के विकास के लिए सर्वाधिक महत्पूर्ण घटक है। तसर उद्योग की आवश्यकताओं एवं अपेक्षाओं की पूर्ति हेतु संस्थान का प्रशिक्षण प्रभाग केन्द्रीय रेशम बोर्ड एवं तसर उत्पादन करने वाले राज्यों के रेशम विभाग/निदेशालय व गैर-सरकारी संस्थाओं से सम्बद्ध वैज्ञानिकों, अधिकारियों एवं तकनीकी/प्रक्षेत्र कर्मचारियों, कृषकों, रेशम धागाकारों/बुनकरों तथा तसर उद्योग से जुड़े अन्य उद्यमियों व बेरोजगार युवकों के लिए प्रशिक्षण एवं विकास कार्यक्रम संचालित करता है। ये प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम संस्थान के अनुभवी एवं योग्य वैज्ञानिकों द्वारा संचालित किए जाते हैं। अधिकांश प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम

केन्द्रीय रेशम बोर्ड अथवा निधि मुहैया कराने वाली एजेंसियों के द्वारा प्रायोजित होते हैं। संस्थान में विद्यार्थियों एवं प्रशिक्षणार्थियों के लिए छात्रावास सुविधा उपलब्ध कराती है।

संस्थान के प्रशिक्षण प्रभाग के निम्नलिखित प्रमुख उद्देश्य हैं :

- राँची विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा स्थायी सम्बद्धता प्राप्त कर पन्द्रह माह की अविध का वन्य रेशम में स्नातकोत्तर डिप्लोमा एवं कई अल्पाविध प्रमाण-पत्र तथा तदर्थ पाठ्यक्रम के माध्यम से प्रशिक्षण प्रदान कर तसर संवर्धन में प्रशिक्षित मानव संसाधन सृजन करना।
- केवीके, विभिन्न संस्थानों के वैज्ञानिकों, अधिकारियों/कर्मचारियों को आवश्यकता आधारित औपचारिक एवं अनौपचारिक मानव संसाधन प्रशिक्षण एवं विकास कार्यक्रमों की अधिकल्पना एवं कार्यान्वयन।
- किसानों एवं बेरोजगार युवकों को सफल उद्यमी बनाने के लिए सुलभ अभयास-जन्य व्यावहारिक प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करना।
- आवश्यकतानुसार भारत सरकार के अनुदेशानुसार रेशमात्पादन लाभार्थियों के लिए विभिन्न विषयों जैसे केवीके, स्टेप, जेम इत्यादि पर व्यावहारिक प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करना।
- विभिन्न संस्थानों/विश्वविद्यालयों के स्नातक/स्नातकोत्तर छात्रों को जैव प्रौद्योगिकी सहित तसर संवर्धन के विभिन्न पहलुओं में परियोजना कार्य/ शोध प्रबंध करने के लिए संस्थान सुविधाएं भी प्रदान करता है।

Training Facilities: Training Division is equipped with modern audio-visual (interactive panels) and air conditioned class room facilities, supported with professionally competent scientists-cum-faculty. It has well-equipped Laboratories, Computer facility with LAN and Internet, rearing fields and grainages for practical training.

Hostel Facility: CTRTI has well furnished hostel facility for trainees. The hostels have facilities for indoor and outdoor games and other recreations. Several other amenities like medical services, transport, communication, etc. are also available for the welfare of the trainees and students. There is separate wing of hostel rooms for boys and girls. Separate accommodation is also available for the farmer trainees. Also, facilities at Jharkhand Agriculture & Soil Management Institute (JASMIN, Govt. of Jharkhand) at Piska Nagri, Rachi are utilized for lodging of farmers, as per need from time to time. The Training Division of the Institute conducts different Training Courses, as detailed below.

^{*}In case of sponsored candidates, the sponsoring agency will have to remit the entire course fee (50% from candidate + 50% Sponsored amount) directly to the concerned training institute at the time of admission. However, in the event of non-remittance of course fee by sponsoring agency, the same will have to be paid by the concerned candidate.

Essential Qualification: The candidate should possess Graduate degree from recognized Indian university in biological sciences or Graduate degree in any discipline with basic knowledge of sericulture/silk and a reasonable understanding of the basic biological concepts and principle.

Short-listing of candidates: Candidates (Open/Sponsored) fulfilling the essential qualification (Graduate degree in biological sciences) is eligible for admission directly based on available vacancy. Whereas, the candidates possessing degree other than biological science will have to qualify the screening test conducted

by the institute.

Age: The applicants should be in the age group of 21-40 years as on 1st July. However, there is no age limit for inservice candidates working in Department of Sericulture of various States.

Medium of instruction: English

Accommodation: Accommodation will be provided in the hostel against payment of a nominal charge of Rs.50/per person/day (twin sharing) and food expenses (actual basis) will be shared equally by all the students.



About CTR&TI

Central Tasar Research and Training Institute (CTRTI) is one of the premier Institutes of Central Silk Board, Ministry of Textiles, Govt. of India. It was established in 1964 as Central Tasar Research Station (CTRS) with a prime objective of providing R&D support to Tasar Silk Industry. Later, to fulfill the requirement of Human Resource Development & Training for progress of Tasar industry, the training component was added to CTRS, giving its present name - CTRTI. The Institute is having its Research and Administrative building, tasar host plantation as well as residential quarters spread over in an area of 86.31 acres of land. Besides, with its network of Six Regional stations (RSRS), one P4-TBS and three Research Extension Centres (REC), one Raw Material Bank at Chaibasa, the Institute provides the state-of-the-art technological know-how to the command states, both under tropical and temperate tasar sector.

For the overall growth of Tasar Silk Industry, CTRTI is primarily engaged in formulation of R&D programmes, development of improved technologies & their transfer to the field, human resource development & training and formulation of societal development programmes. The Institute undertakes all sorts of R&D programmes, including molecular level to unearth the intricacies of tasar silkworm for breaking the barrier of productivity and quality. It has well equipped R&D sections with a wide range of modern equipments and a Library having good collection of scientific journals of international repute, books and technical reports. Though the Institute performs all its activities on the funds made available from Ministry of Textiles - Govt. of India, it also receives funds from other Govt. agencies like Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Govt. of India, New Delhi etc. for implementation of specific R&D and HRD based projects.

Training Programmes

Human resource is one of the most critical components for the growth of an industry. To meet the growing needs and expectations of tasar silk industry, Training Division of CTRTI runs various Human Resource Development & Training programmes for the Scientists, Officers and technical/field staff of Central Silk Board (CSB),

Department/Directorate of Sericulture (DOS) and NGOs from different tasar silk producing States; and also farmers, silk reelers/spinners, unemployed youths and other stakeholders of tasar silk industry. These programmes are conducted by highly experienced and qualified scientists of CTRTI. Most of the training programmes are fully sponsored by the CSB/ funding agencies. The institute provides hostel facilities for students and trainees. Training Division of Institute has the following prime objectives:

- To generate human resource by imparting training through fifteen month duration "Post-Graduate Diploma in Vanya Silk" course which is affiliated to Ranchi University, Ranchi and many short-term Certificate & Adhoc courses in Tasar Sericulture.
- To design and implement the need-based formal and informal human resource training and development programmes to KVKs, Scientists, Officers/officials of different institutions etc.
- To provide hands-on-practice training to farmers and unemployed youths for helping them to become successful entrepreneurs.
- Time to time, as per instructions of Govt. of India, hands on training on different subjects like KVK, STEP, GeM, etc. are imparted to the sericulture beneficiaries.
- The Institute also provides facilities to undergraduates / post graduate students from different Institutions / Universities to carry out project works / dissertations in different aspects of tasar culture, including biotechnology.
